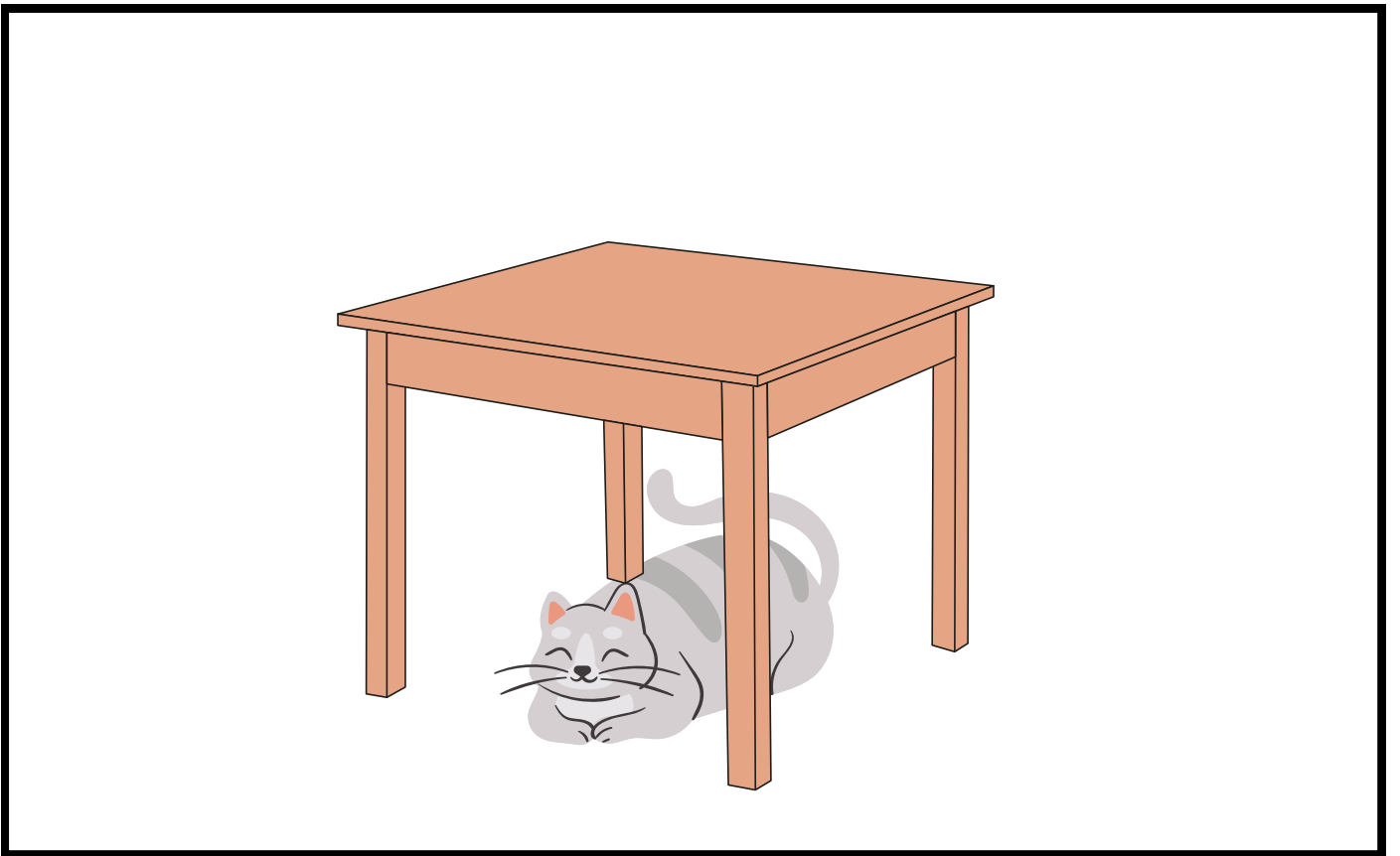
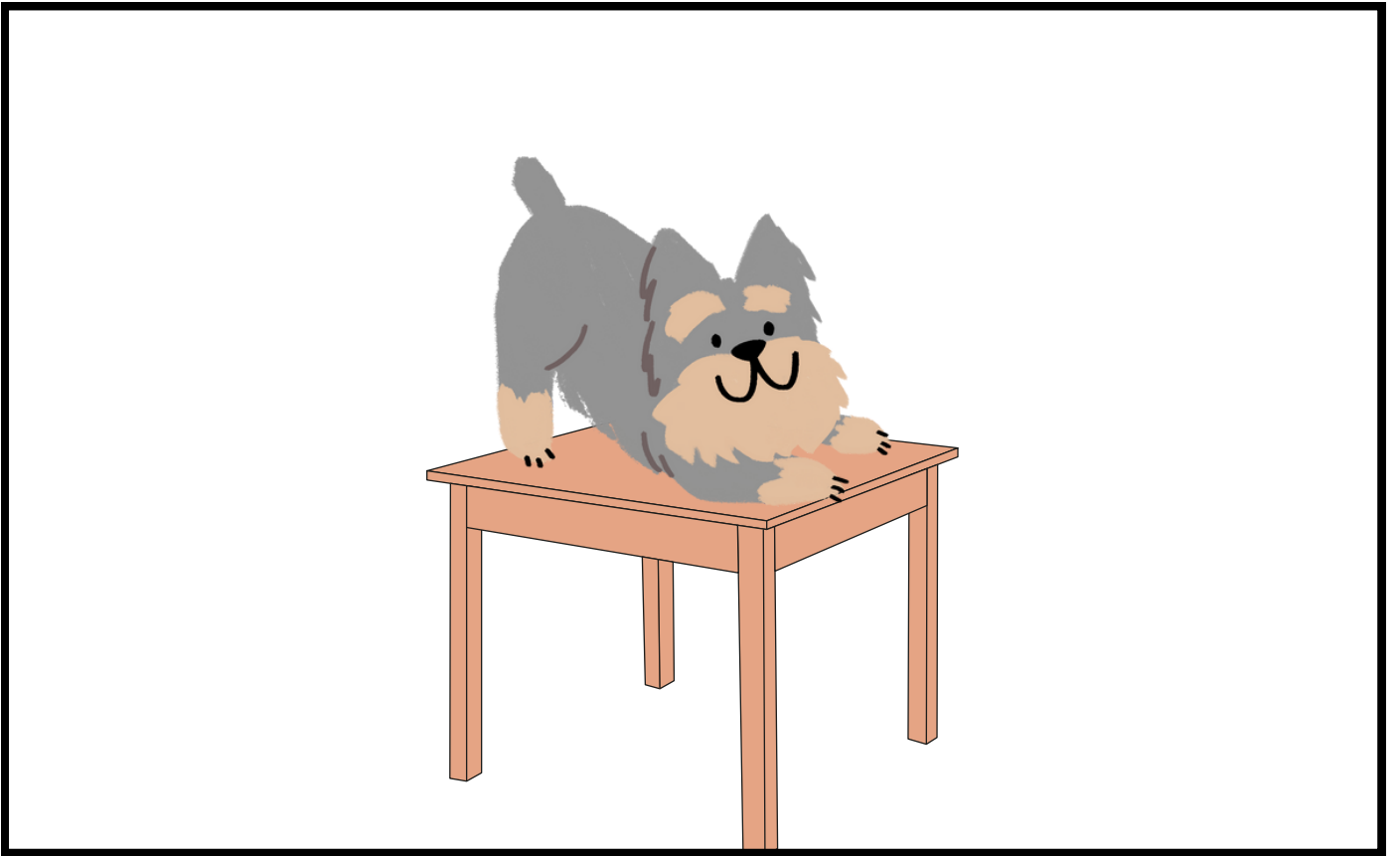
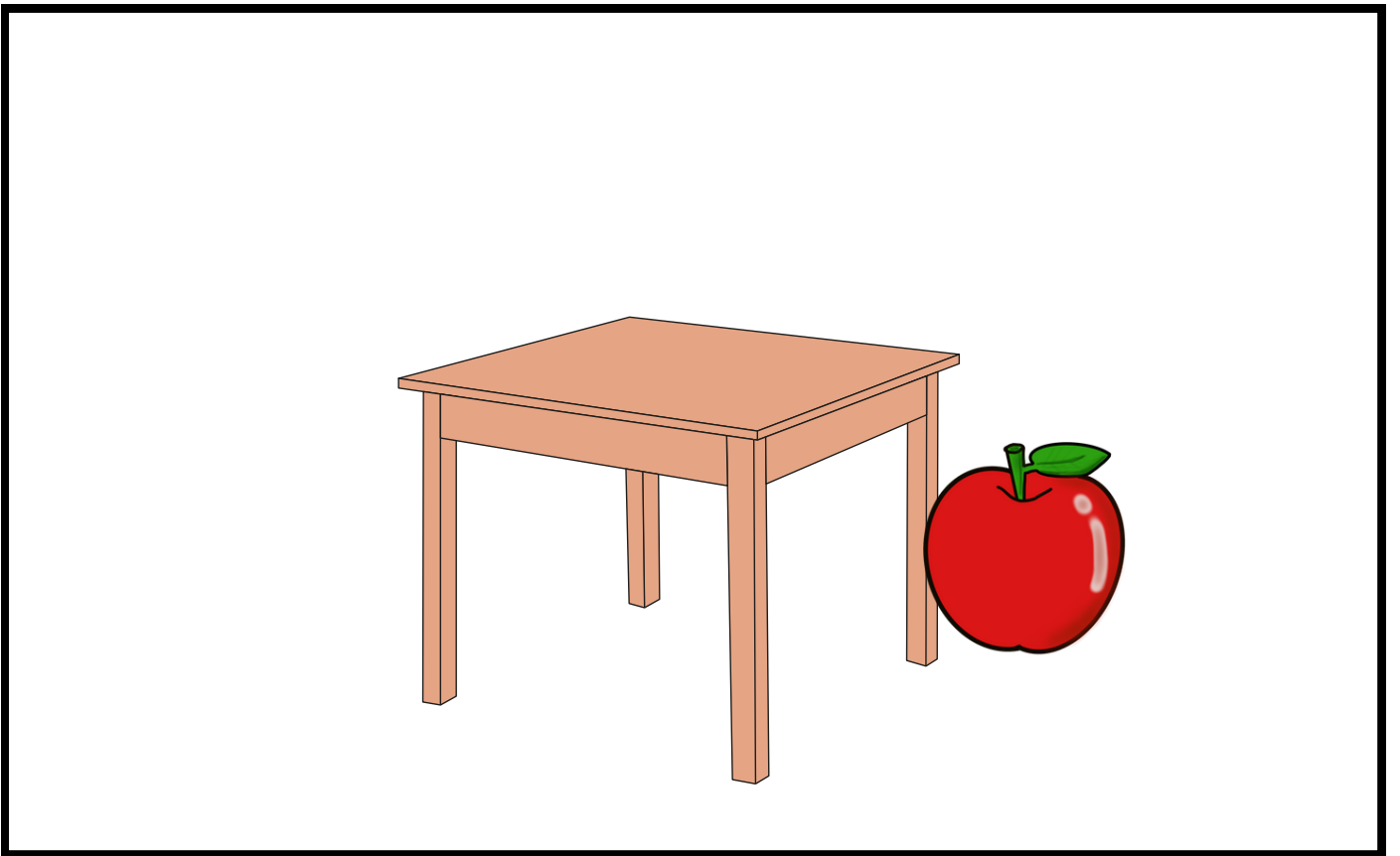
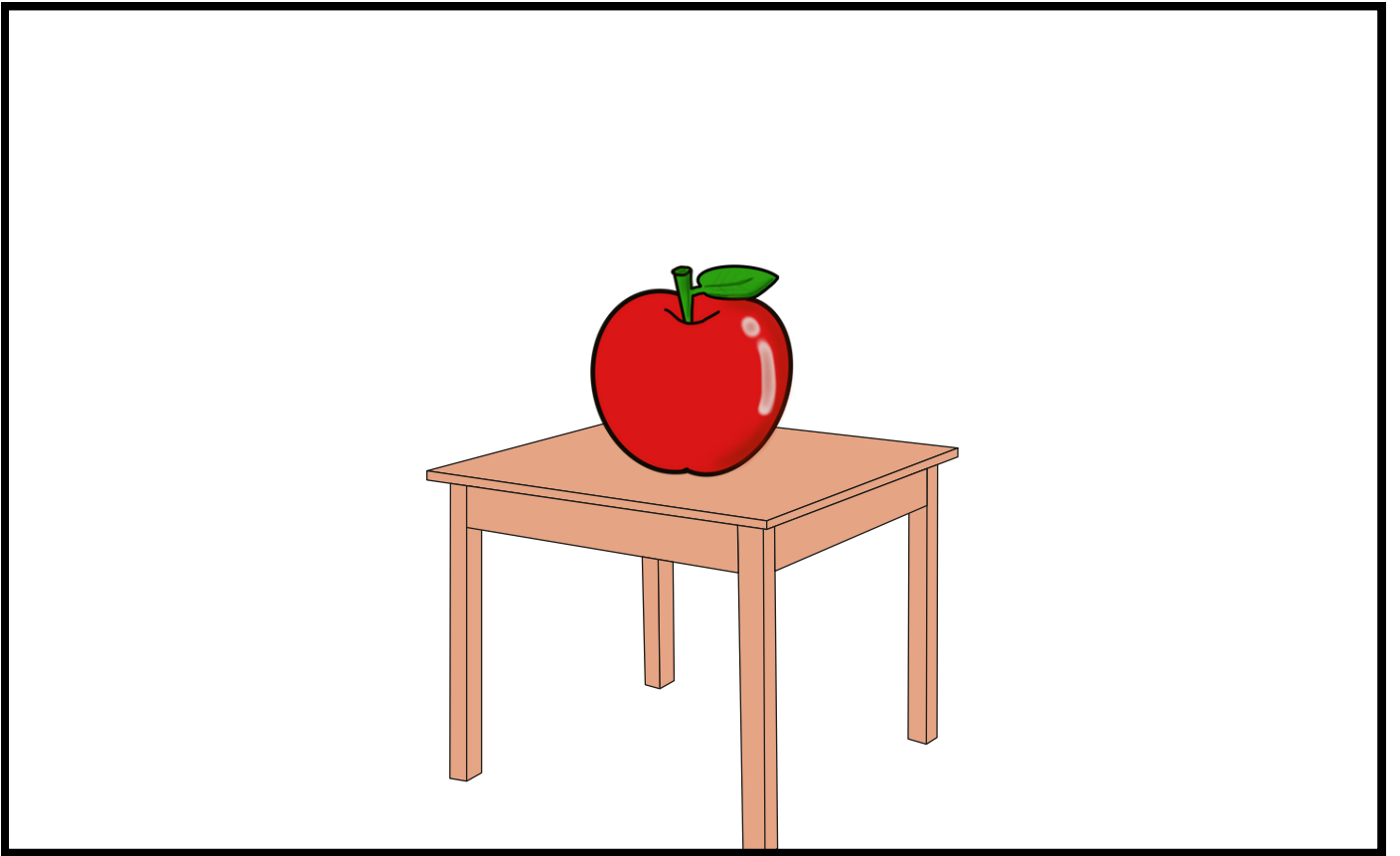


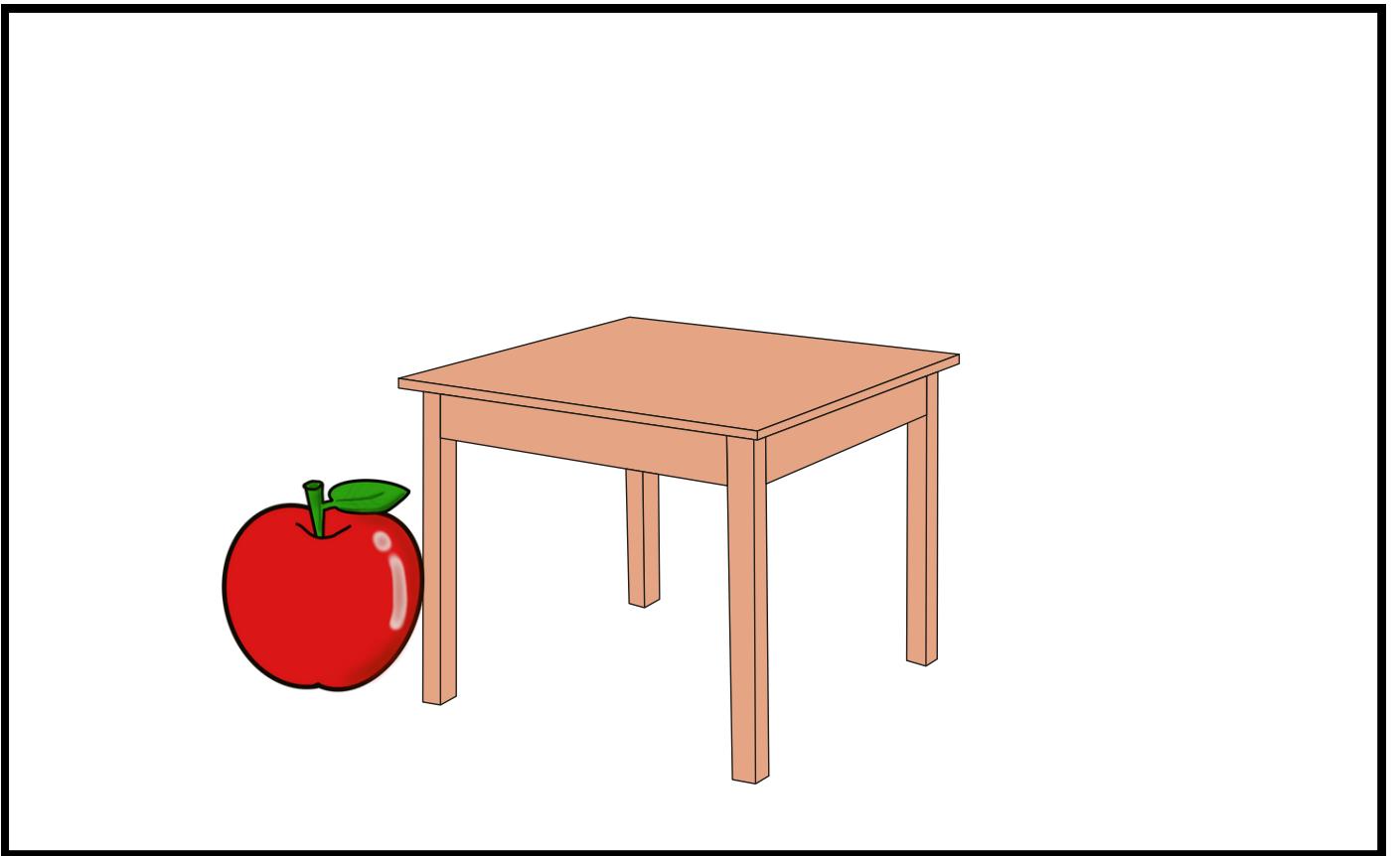
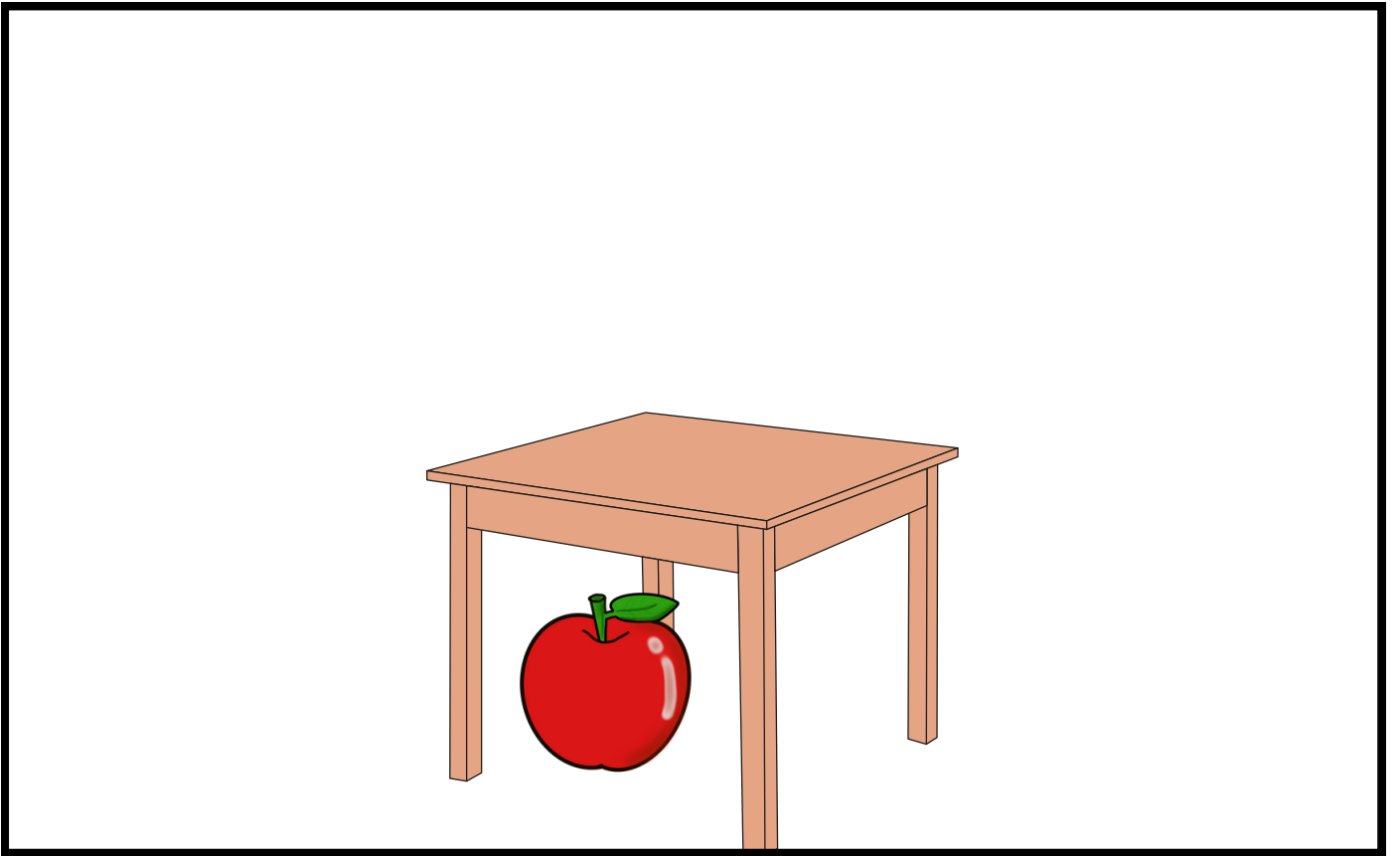
How to use:

- Print, cut, and laminate
- For receptive skills: Utilize velcro. Ask the learner "Put the (item) (preposition)".
- For expressive skills: Present the image and ask "where is (item)?"
- Keep in mind the age of the learner when determining the appropriateness of this resources and the images used (i.e., age appropriateness)
- Print as many copies as needed
- To assure generalization, it is strongly recommended that therapists use other modes of teaching, such as naturally asking the learner to label and receptively identify prepositions

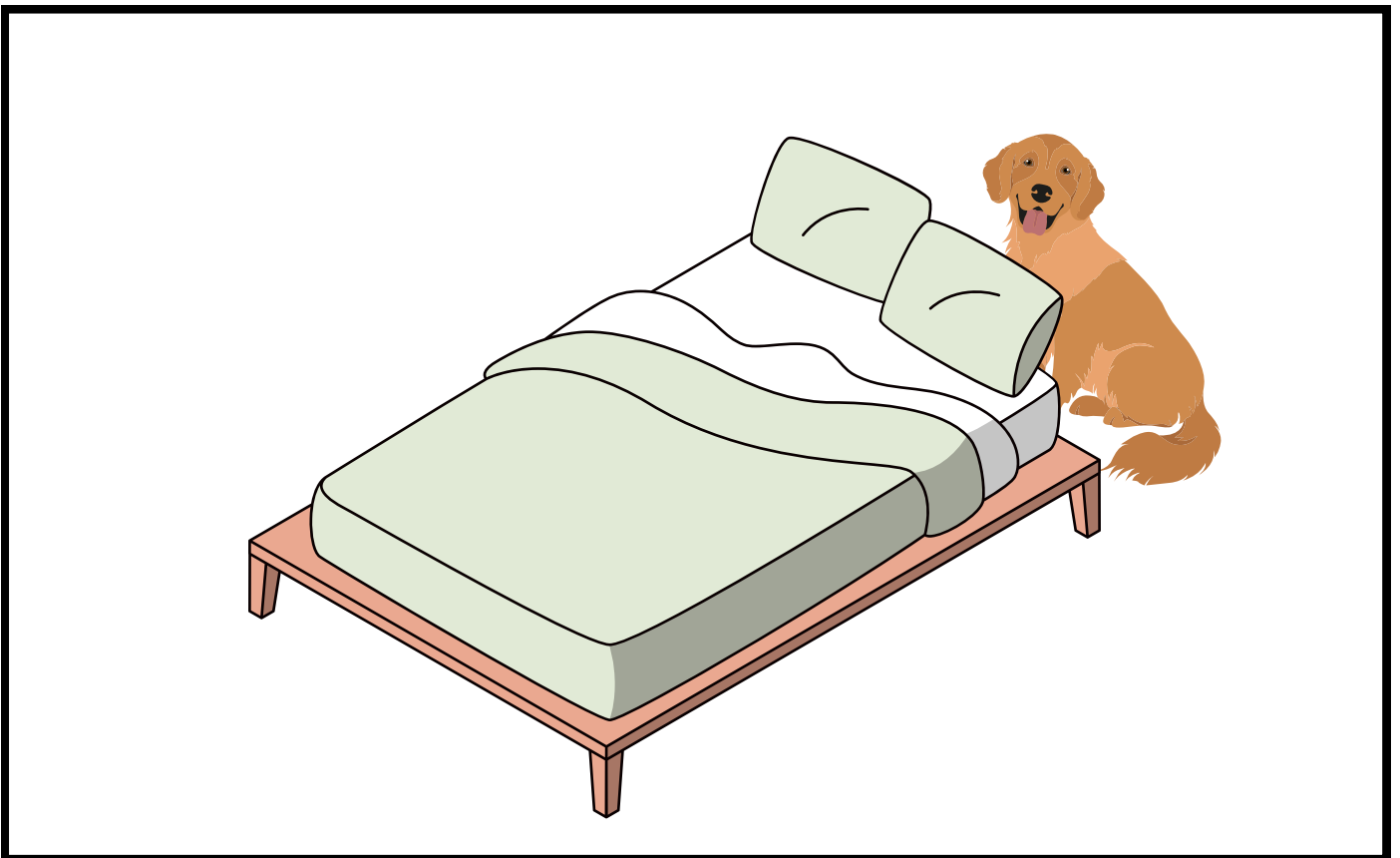
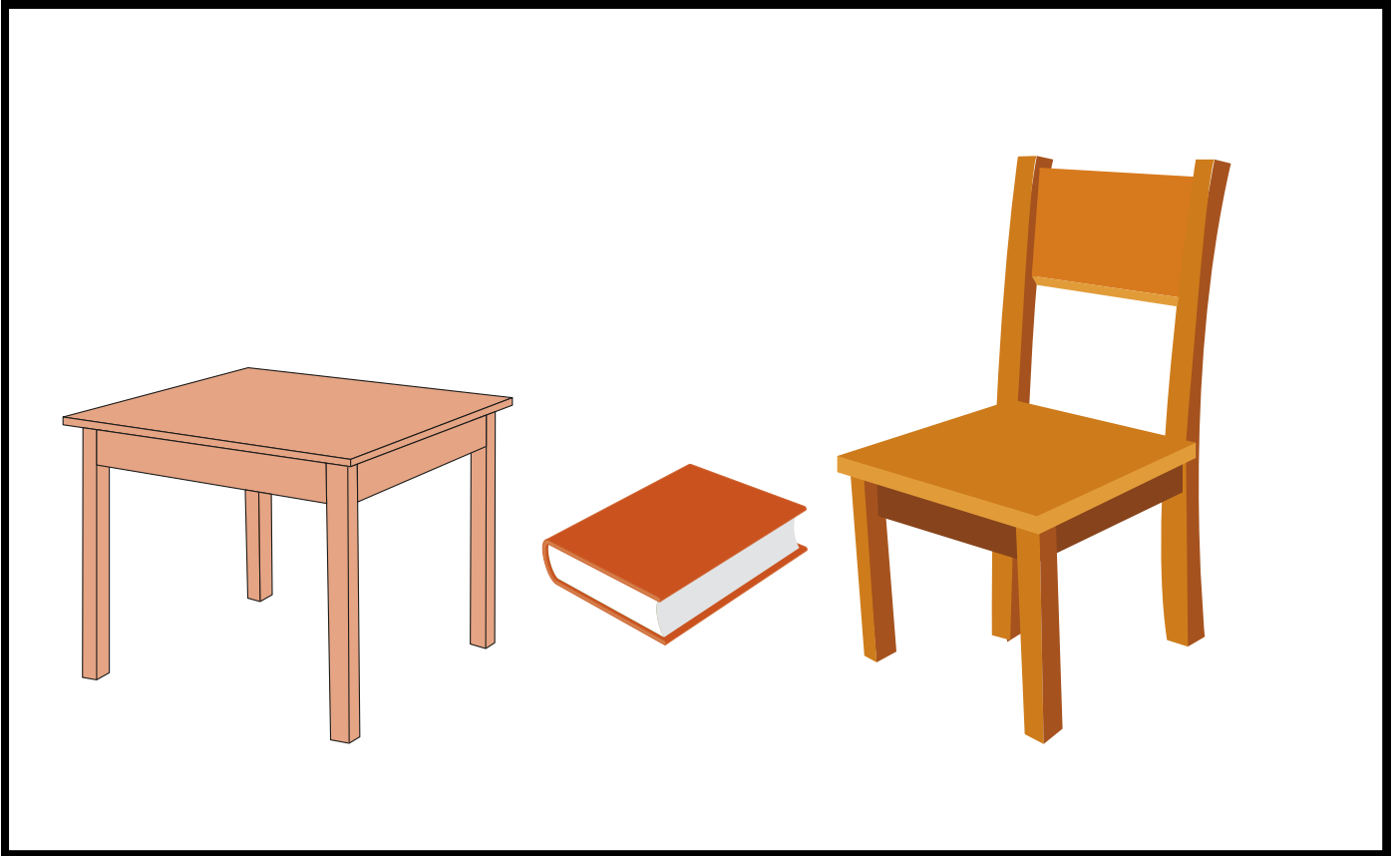
